



Conditions of Entry

All persons entering this Venue consent to and agree to comply with all of the following Conditions of Entry:

1. Spectator Code of Conduct

- a) Respect the decisions of games officials and teach young people to do the same.
- b) Never ridicule or scald a young player for making a mistake.
- c) Condemn the use of violence in any form, whether it is by other spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- d) Show respect for your team's opponents. Applaud good performance and efforts from all players and teams. Congratulate all players on their performance regardless of the game's outcome.
- e) Do not use violence, harassment or abuse in any form (ie., do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators). No obscene or indecent messages on signs or clothing.
- f) Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- g) Not to be intoxicated or unruly during pre-game and game activities.
- h) Not interfere with the play of the game in any manner. This includes running onto the field or throwing objects onto the field of play.
- i) Respect the rights and decisions of the staff/volunteers charged with the supervision and wellbeing of players and the game. Encourage players to follow the rules and the officials' decisions.

2. Prohibited items:

The following must not be brought into this Venue:

- a) Alcohol, glassware, weapons or implements (knives, screwdrivers etc.), fireworks, firearms, flares, laser pointers or any other object that may cause harm to any person.
- b) Drones, model airplanes or other electronic or motorised flying devices and must not be used in this Venue without prior authorisation.
- c) Prohibited or illegal substances.

3. Smoking (including e-cigarettes):

Smoking (including E-cigarettes) in this Venue is only permitted in designated smoking areas. All other spaces or within 10 meters of the Venues entrances and perimeter is prohibited at all times.

4. Cameras and recording equipment:

To ensure patron privacy is maintained, cameras, including mobile phones with camera interfacing, must not be used in change rooms or toilets.

Photos/videos of minors are not to be taken without explicit permission from the parents/guardians.



5. Vehicle entry

Only emergency and authorised vehicles are permitted within this Venue at any time.

Do not park in gateways or in designated no parking/standing zones.

7. Patrons use Venue at own Risk

Persons entering and using this Venue and its facilities do so at their own risk, and are responsible for ensuring the security of any personal items brought into the Venue, at all times.

Parking during any sanctioned event is at the owner's risk. Baseball NT / Softball NT are not liable for any vehicle damage as a result of fly balls.

Persons found to be non-compliant with the Conditions of Entry may be removed or in extreme cases sanctioned under the relevant governing body.
