- 1. Be a positive role model for Baseball/Softball at all times and value the individual.
- 2. Participate within the rules and competition conditions.
- 3. Participate in the spirit of fair play and commit to be a good sportsperson by acknowledging displays of athleticism regardless of allegiance.
- 4. Be a dignified participant by being modest in victory and gracious in defeat.
- 5. Comply with umpire's and all other officials' decisions in a professional and respectful manner. When appealing a decision, always follow all due processes and maintain a professional and respectful manner.
- 6. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people. Refrain from any discriminatory practices against any person regardless of age, gender, ethnic origin, religion, or ability.
- 7. Refrain from making derogatory, demeaning, or discriminatory remarks about any administrators, players, coaches, or others. Refrain from abusing officials (verbally or physically) and deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent.
- 8. Refrain from any form of sexual innuendo or harassment towards any player, coach or official. This includes explicit, implicit, verbal, and non-verbal sexual harassment. Refrain from initiating inappropriate relationships.
- 9. Be professional in your appearance and manner and accept responsibility for your actions.
  - a. Display high standards in language, manner, punctuality, preparation, and presentation. Working equally hard for yourself and your team.
  - b. Display control, respect, dignity, and professionalism to all involved with Baseball/Softball, including opponents, coaches, officials, umpires, scorers, administrators, the media, parents, and spectators. Refrain from bullying or taking unfair advantage of another competitor.
  - c. Do not tolerate acts of aggression.
  - d. Maintain high standards of personal appearance and behaviour. Express gratitude to the opposition and officials at the end of a game.
  - e. Participate for enjoyment.
  - f. Encourage others to demonstrate the same qualities.





- 10. Abstain from participating in Baseball/Softball activities whilst deemed under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 11. Comply with all policies and procedures from your applicable sporting body. Refrain from engaging in any behaviour that is in breach of those policies and procedures.
